A four-year college degree is required for this position. A degree in environmental sciences is preferred; however, the District may consider applicants with a degree in business or governmental administration. Candidate must also have at least five years' experience in in the fields of environmental science, geology, hydrology or local government administration. Strong interpersonal, communication, financial planning, budgeting, public speaking, writing, and technology skills are required. Knowledge of groundwater resources, geology, water production or water science is preferred.
