

## Internship Opportunity

Do you enjoy the **outdoors**? Are you interested in **science** and the **environment**? Rolling Plains Groundwater Conservation District is seeking a summer intern to assist with a unique, water-related project. Tasks might involve sampling and testing stormwater and groundwater, measuring a watershed, creating a database, or presenting your findings to others. College credit is available at certain institutions.

The District may fund one or more internships in 2023. Interns can expect to work between 5 and 20+ hours per week and are compensated on an hourly basis. Hours are flexible and will vary depending on rainfall events and the needs of the District. Some work outside of regular office hours or after inclement weather is anticipated.

The successful person must be able to communicate well, safely lift 25 pounds, walk a mile carrying a ten-pound backpack, and have a clean driving record.
