Position Description:

Responsible for performing skilled tasks to achieve the District's management goals including the District's monitoring well network, well plugging program, and the Groundwater Well Assistance Program.

Position Responsibilities:

- This position reports to the Water Resources Manager
- Communication with people from the community on a daily basis
- Installing, maintaining, troubleshooting and preventative maintenance on well monitoring equipment
- Assist the Water Resources Manager in determining wells that qualify for the District's Groundwater Well Assistance Program
- Assist the Water Resource Manager in determining wells that qualify for the District's Plugging Program
- Perform downhole camera inspections
- Must be able and willing to work alone, work overtime, and schedule work as needed
- Must understand and comply with the District's Guidance Document
- Work assignments carried out to the highest quality level while maintaining commitment to customer service and professional working relationships with customers and co-workers
- Perform well inspections
- Perform other duties and activities as assigned by the Water Resource Manager or the General Manager

- Basic understanding of well construction and aquifer dynamics
